As I have worked to lead a Church into all kinds of personal and corporate victories through the study and teaching of the Word of God and a lot of prayer, I have noticed that sometimes we seem to get “stuck” and really don’t know how to contend with the demons that are assigned to keep us from seeing all that God has promised from being fulfilled in our lives. Sometimes we don’t know what we’re up against, and sometimes it’s simply God’s word testing us to see if we truly do believe all that He has spoken through His word, and to see if we will absolutely and completely trust Him to look after us as He continues to lead us.

Our Father has a “promised land” for us all. He has seen our affliction and has rescued us through the power of the Cross, but sometimes we simply don’t enter into His promises due to the intimidation we face, often because there are “giants” in the way that need to be taken out. God in all His glory thought it would be even more glorious to share powerful victories with His children, so in His wisdom, He has set things up for us to experience this in many ways.

God really loves us, and has an incredible journey filled with healing, deliverance, joy, love, mercy, grace, power, wisdom, wonder, and inheritance, and there is a very real devil who has organized his demonic realms to try to keep you and I in submission to his lies, as he often effectively steals the good things from us that God has laid up for us.

As sons and daughters, through Jesus, God has given us the power and authority to use the “keys of the Kingdom” to “bind and loose” whatever is needed, and to understand that Jesus has put all these things under our feet, in order “preach the Gospel” effectively and powerfully, and “make disciples of nations”. God, The Father has always been all confident in Himself, and has never been intimidated by the devil nor his puny plans. In fact, “God sits in the Heavens and laughs and puts His enemies in derision” (Psalm 2:4). We must always remember that satan has never been Father God’s rival. The devil is a created being that God can wipe out anytime He chooses. In

That is what it's all about!



As we move into March, I have found myself musing in the book of 2nd Peter.

In March we half-heartedly accept

the notion that there is supernatural provision in a pot of gold at the end of a rainbow somewhere. The world allows itself to toy with the idea of something beyond the natural... the supernatural... the divine.

I'm struck by the words in 2nd Peter chapter one where Peter talks about the "divine". He refers to a "divine power" and a "divine nature" that you are I as believers are supposed to have access to. A divine nature and power that is beyond our natural ability and our human nature.

The word "divine" means of or from the gods, or sent by the gods", this means that there is a power and a nature that is not human nature that we can have access to and walk in, and keys to that divine power and nature are in the book of **2nd Peter!** So, let's read this little book (*only 3 chapters*) at least 10 times this month.

Again, the repetition is what gets it into our spirit so that even when we think our natural mind has forgotten, our spirit learns and grows and helps us to walk out the divine nature we are called to live in.

Study the keys to this divine nature and ask yourself where you are lacking? His divine power gives us the grace to walk in a divine nature that will separate us from the norm and allow us to be a testimony to the world around us.

## KINGS OF CANAAN *continued...*

Exodus 3:7 And the Lord said: "I have surely seen the oppression of My people who are in Egypt, and have heard their cry because of their taskmasters, for I know their sorrows. 8 So I have come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up from that land to a good and large land, to a land flowing with milk and honey, to the place of the Canaanites and the Hittites and the Amorites and the Perizzites and the Hivites and the Jebusites. 9 Now therefore, behold, the cry of the children of Israel has come to Me, and I have also seen the oppression with which the Egyptians oppress them. 10 Come now, therefore, and I will send you to Pharaoh that you may bring My people, the children of Israel, out of Egypt." NKJV

God called Abram from a place called Ur from the land of the Chaldeans which was located South East of Babylon or what we would now call Iraq... God took him on a 25 year hike all around the land of Canaan, to Egypt, then back to Canaan. He loved Abraham. He called him His friend and made a covenant with him which promised He would make Abraham the Father of many nations, and would give him the land of Canaan as an inheritance as a place where his descendants would live and be a sign to the rest of the world, a people that God could reveal Himself through.

God miraculously gave Abraham a son, Isaac in his old age, who became the avenue of God's promise... but because of a severe famine, the people of Israel ended up living in Egypt for 400 years as God used Joseph (one of Abraham's great grandsons) to help the nation survive its severity. Many years before it happened, God told Abraham that his descendants would end in slavery in that Nation, but God Himself would lead them out... but not as slaves, but a very rich people.

This story is a prophetic display of the future plan of redemption that would be completed through Jesus. Abraham means "father of nations", a picture of God, The Father of heaven and Earth, who brought forth His promised Son to redeem the world. Isaac was Abraham's "promised son". Isaac means "he laughs". Egypt represents mankind's slavery to sin and death, and it is God, The Father's joy to deliver mankind, and as was men-

tioned already in Psalm 2; "God laughs and puts His enemies in derision". God has all confidence in Himself and

laughs at the strategies of those who would try to war against Him. His joy is for us to receive His promise, and He delights to give us His joy in the process.

Exodus 3: 21

21 And I will give this people favor in the sight of the Egyptians; and it shall be, when you go, that you shall not go empty-handed. 22 But every woman shall ask of her neighbor, namely, of her who dwells near her house, articles of silver, articles of gold, and clothing; and you shall put them on your sons and on your daughters. So you shall plunder the Egyptians." NKJV

God performed incredible signs and wonders through His servant Moses in the presence of Pharaoh to convince him to let the Israelites go and finally after the nation of Egypt had severely suffered from the plague judgements, Pharaoh conceded and they began a 40 year journey. God took Israel from slavery, but for the next 40 years, God worked at getting the "slavery mindset out of them", despite the fact that they were given Egypt's gold and silver as they left. Once they were out of Egypt and into the wilderness, even more signs, wonders, and miracles were performed on their behalf as God led them with a pillar of fire at night and cloud by day. He parted the Red Sea when there was no escape from Pharaoh's army, supplied food and water supernaturally, and just because He could, caused their clothes and shoes to never wear out. Go demonstrated His provision, goodness, and great power on behalf of the people of Israel to help them to trust that He would do what He said He would, that He would always be faithful to them if they did what He asked of them, and more than anything else, desired to bless them so much that they would become a blessing to the world, and would fulfill His covenant with His good friend Abraham. He would give them the rich land of Canaan as their inheritance, and would be their God forever.

But...eventually they needed to face the giants that were in the land they were to occupy. They needed to subdue them, and have dominion over them, and He would back them up the whole way. So God did! The people of Israel faced the

kings of the Land of Canaan which the Lord said He had given into their hand. He assured them of great victory as He backed them up, but they still had to displace these kings and occupy the land. This was a new generation, the old had passed away. This generation only knew the miraculous provision of God, but now had to learn to fight battles with their own skill and energy. They would learn to plant, hunt, and gather in their harvests. God was not going to provide in the same way He had for the past 40 years. God took them out of Egypt, and spent 40 years getting the Egypt out of them. Now, they were beginning to see the inheritance they were finally to receive from the Lord. They faced the trafficking spirit of Mammon... the Canaanites, which leads to lusting after money, and the evil things a person can do with it... leads to various wicked indulgence. (Sodom and Gomorrah... sodomy is very much alive and well in our culture) The Hittites; The paralyzing spirit of fear, the terrorists . The Amorites – The babbling spirit of confusion that comes from 5 different directions at once. It brings an evil report in order to dishearten you, and a controlling spirit that will work to even turn your friends against you. It comes at you with huge amounts of knowledge to make you think that it really knows what's going on and to bring a false peace... It's a very evil and nasty liar. The Jebusites; the spirit that tries to run you over and beat you down in order for you to become so disheartened that you will give up on the promise and inheritance of God... you feel like you got run over by a freight train... tries to make you feel small and insignificant, and every time you get up... like the bully that it is, kicks you right back down... They faced the Perrizzites; that come at you with doubts and uncertainty, in order to make you become unsure, hesitant, undecided and undisciplined regarding the things of God, and the will of God for your life. They also were required to take out the Hivittes. The Hivitte spirit is in close relationship with the Perizzite spirit (unwalled city) in that "Hivitte" means "belonging to a village". A village mentality is about simple existence... you just simply exist. You don't dream of great exploits... everything is just "nice and peaceful here". The undisciplined life, coupled with no dream of accomplishment or great exploits keep you in a state of insignificance, because "you really don't matter anyway".

So for us, living under the New Covenant, we face

many of the same things, as God commissions us to preach the Good News of His Kingdom to every people group on planet Earth. To set captives free, pray for the sick, and make disciples of nations. (Matt 28:19, Mark 16:15-18) God has great and glorious plans for us, and desires to lead us by His Spirit into the full inheritance He has for us as well. He has given all of us some sort of personal promise of destiny, something for us to accomplish for His kingdom, and something to receive from Him that is our "promised land", but in order for us to see it and occupy, we have to face some giants as well.

Consider the parable of the ten talents. God has given each of us something to use for Kingdom purposes, to invest, take risk, to multiply, to overcome, and finally, "to prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers". (3 John 2) Those who used their gift wisely were given more to govern, but those who didn't were removed completely from the picture.

Just as God led Israel, so He leads His Church to radical victory over the wicked hosts that have squatted on our promises. It's time for us to become educated and skilled in the power of The Holy Spirit and Word of God, in order to walk in victory and receive our inheritance promise from the Father.

Many times we're happy to pray for revival and have seen a measure of change in our personal lives and possibly our churches for a little while, but have seen little to no change in our communities. We have seen the laws of our land deteriorate, morality degenerate, and have become subject to un-Godly legislation. What if the Lord would like to bring complete transformation to our cities and nation through the transformation of His people? I believe this is the heart of the commission; "make disciples of the nations."

I believe that the keys found in some of these truths, have the power to do all of that through people who choose to believe what The Bible says, and will be brave enough to do what the Bible says. God has an inheritance for each of us... are we willing to face the giants and move into all that the Lord desires us to have?...




